Definition of a spiritual gift: It is a supernatural ability given by Christ through the Holy Spirit to the believer at the moment of his salvation.

There is a distinction between spiritual gifts and human talents.

-**Talent** is a human and natural ability given at birth.

-A **gift** is supernatural and is received at one's second birth.
