2 Corinthians 5:14-16 (ESV) ¹⁴ For the love of Christ _____, because we have concluded this: that one has died for all, therefore all have died; ¹⁵ and he died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised. ¹⁶ From now on, therefore, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we once regarded Christ according to the flesh, we regard him thus no longer.

Colossians 3:5-10 (Easy-to-Read Version) ⁵ So put everything evil _____: sexual sin, doing anything immoral, letting sinful thoughts control you, and wanting things that are wrong. And don’t keep wanting _____ for yourself, which is the same as worshiping a false god. ⁶ God will show his anger against those who _____ obey him, because they do these evil things. ⁷ You also did these things in the past, when you lived like them. ⁸ But now put these things out of your life: anger, losing your temper, doing or saying things to hurt others, and saying shameful things. ⁹ Don’t lie to each other. You have taken off those old clothes—the person you once were and the bad things you did then. ¹⁰ Now you are wearing a _____ life, a life that is new every day.
